

Individual Housing General Policies & Procedures

- 1. Entrance doors to the residence halls are locked 24 hours a day. Anyone entering any building must do so with a swipe card or be allowed in by the building staff.
- 2. No alcohol is allowed in rooms where the guests are under 21 years of age. Guests 21 years of age or older may have alcohol in their room only and not in the hallways or other public areas.
- 3. Guests may not have or consume federally illegal drugs (including marijuana in any form and paraphernalia), or improperly use any controlled substances (including alcohol) on DU property.
- 4. The University of Denver is a 100% smoke-free campus, meaning that smoking is not permitted indoors or outdoors on campus property. Visit www.du.edu/smokefree for more information.
- 5. If there is a fire alarm or there is a fire in the building, **EXIT THE BUILDING RIGHT AWAY**. Do not go back to your room for your belongings. Go outside and gather with other residents at a safe distance away from the building. Follow the directions of University of Denver staff on duty. DO NOT go back into the building until it has been cleared to do so by the fire department.
- 6. It is a criminal offense to pull a fire alarm if there is no fire or danger of a fire. If an alarm is pulled by a resident, he/she may be removed from the residence hall or building and asked to leave the University of Denver. Charges may also be filed against him/her.
- 7. If there is a tornado warning, go to the basement of the building. If you are in a building where there is no basement, go to a bathroom or covered room that is not near windows.
- 8. Quiet hours are Sunday-Thursday 10:00pm 7:00am and Friday and Saturday 12:00am to 9:00am. Please be considerate of those around you.
- 9. If you are caught throwing items out the window of your room you may be asked to leave the University of Denver.
- 10. Refrigerators in the residence hall rooms may be used. If the refrigerator is left unclean upon check-out you will be assessed an "excessively dirty" fee.
- 11. An "excessively dirty" fee will also be assessed for any room that requires a "deep clean" upon the departure of the Guest.
